

**Directions:** Print on cardstock ("Fit to Page" setting); fold along center line (as closely as possible); cut around image outline (with or without extra whitespace for a nice border).  
Laminate front & back pieces together (text facing outwards on both sides); punch hole in center top circle outline if desired.
